



China: 1912 Lithographed Postal Forgery of 4¢ Waterlow with Shanghai 'Republic' Overprint (Scott #150) with faked roller postmark. Fine-Very Fine.

Both the basic stamp and overprint are lithographed.

China: 1915 (ca.) Engraved Postal Forgery of 10¢ Junk, Perf 11, Mint. Perf faults but otherwise sound and fresh with full 'original' gum. With a genuine mint stamp (Scott #211) for comparison.

Very rare in Mint state.



China: 1915 (ca.) Engraved Postal Forgery of the First Peking 50¢ Reaper, Mint with large part original gum. Minor scuffs, otherwise fresh and Fine-Very Fine. With a genuine Mint stamp (Scott #235) for comparison.

In addition to numerous design differences from the genuine stamp, this forgery is Perf 16, which doesn't exist on any genuine First Peking stamps.



China: 1915 (ca.) Engraved Postal Forgery of First Peking 50¢ Reaper (Scott #235) Imperf Left-Margin Horizontal Pair. Full original gum with some gum creases. Fresh and Fine-Very Fine.
