I have examined the following stamps from:
RUSSIA, SOVIET UNION

FAR EASTERN REPUBLIC

1923 Vladivostok Air Mail Issue, overprinted
Владивосток 1923 and surcharged **20 коп** on
Imperial Russia 1k orange, 5k brown lilac, 20k blue & red, 35k
lilac & green and 35/2k green (Far Eastern Republic), each
perforated 14½:15 (*Michel Catalogue* No.45A,49A,53A,55A,58),
unused with original gum, previously hinged (first two) or never
hinged (last three), bearing various signatures, such as "Lissiuk,
N.Y.", "Stolow" and pencil signed Herbert Bloch.

In my opinion, these five stamps, of which a color scan is
attached, are genuine in all philatelic respects and in fine
condition, free of any defects at time of examination.

Only 25-100 of each were issued.
